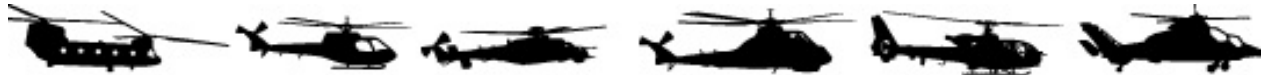


MUSEUM OF THE FORGOTTEN WARRIORS NEWSLETTER # 34 November 2020
